



Today, nearly one-third of people seeking facial rejuvenation surgery are between 35 and 50 years old. Wrinkles and frown

lines often first appear in the brow and forehead area. A forehead lift or browlift can smooth out the wrinkles and correct drooping brows and heavy lids to provide a younger, friendlier appearance.

Although the traditional foreheadlift or browlift is usually the best choice for most patients, **an endoscopic facelift /browlift** can be beneficial for certain select individuals who do not have a significant amount of excess skin. An endoscopic facelift can focus on problems in a specific area of the face, making smaller, more concentrated adjustments. Patients who undergo endoscopic facelifts typically require less recovery time, experience fewer side effects and have lower risk of complications.

What is Endoscopic facelift/browlift?

Endoscopic facelifts/browlifts make use of the latest technology, using small incisions (often less than one inch in length) that are easily hidden. The surgeon performing the endoscopic facelift inserts the endoscope probe, a small camera, and tiny instruments through these incisions.

The procedure

The typical endoscopic facelift /browlift will require three or more short incisions which are concealed in the hairline and/or behind the ears. Because the incisions used in an endoscopic facelift are significantly smaller than those used in a traditional facelift, the risk of sensory loss from nerve damage is decreased. Endoscopic facelift/browlift patients also have significantly reduced bleeding, bruising and swelling, tend to recover more quickly and are often able to return to work and other activities within a week of the procedure.



What will your recovery be like?

There is a minimal amount of discomfort following an endoscopic facelift/browlift. There will be swelling and bruising that may last from five to seven days. For some patients this may include the cheeks and eyelids. Keeping your head elevated and application of cold compress will help to reduce swelling. As your incisions heal, you will notice some itching and possibly some numbness. These symptoms will diminish over time. You may wear make-up after three days, and your sutures will be removed in seven days. Strenuous activity is restricted for three weeks.
